The accession book is a brief inventory of all volumes ever owned by a library, and the entries being in the order of addition to the library it shows the chronological growth. It is the most permanent of all library records as there is no danger of losing or misplacing entries, and it is the final reference for doubtful points. Various valuable statistics may be secured from the accession record; how many volumes ever owned, how many added through purchase, how many through gift, how many discarded and an invoice through the cost column which gives the basis for insurance.

Place of accessioning in the routine

Accessioning follows checking of bill, cost of each book having been written in inner margin of first recto (the right-hand page) after title page, with date of bill and dealer's surname.

Order of entry

Enter one volume to a line and never under any circumstances give the same number to two volumes or to whole sets. No two books should have the same accession number even if the original is lost, sold, exchanged or condemned and an exact duplicate obtained.

Date

The date used should be the date of bill, and if necessary to enter books of a later bill before an earlier one, do so, but never count off lines to allow space for the earlier bill. Use the short abbreviations for dates.

Accession number

Write the accession number in the book in ink on the lower margin of the first recto after the title page, and it is a good practice to enter the number the first thing before any writing is done in the book, as it is sometimes omitted entirely if left for haphazard entry.

Author entry

Surname only, except when necessary to distinguish between authors having the same surname. Then use author abbreviation.

Joint authors. Use both surnames, if two; e. g. Jones & Smith; use surnames of first and phrase "& others," if more than two.

Editor or compiler as author. Add designation "ed.", "comp." etc. 1 cm. after surname.

Pseudonym, if best known, give in full, e. g. Twain, Mark, pseud.

Government publications and corporate entries. Follow catalogue forms; e. g. U. S.-Agriculture dep't; Wis.-Dairy and food com'n. Abbreviate such author entries as much as possible to save space.

Anonymous classics. Use best known form of name in author column; e. g. Arabian nights. Repeat name as it stands on title page, in title column.

Periodicals, almanacs, annuals and directories. Enter under title, in title column. Give dates after title. For periodicals use short title, omit date in 'year' column; give thus, Harper's monthly. Nov. 1887-Apr. 1888.

Anonymous books. Leave author column blank.

Works of two or more authors bound together. Use surname of the first author in author column, and titles and authors of secondary works after title of first in title column.

Title

Brief. Omit initial article except when sense would be destroyed. Do not enclose in curves, when retained.

Never capitalize after an article if it is used, and do not put curves around the article as in cataloguing. Do not use capitals for any words in the title except proper nouns and adjectives. Use no punctuation except for abbreviations and a period at the end of title.

Editor or translator. Add phrase regarding editor, etc., when necessary to distinguish different editions. Use surnames only, e. g. The tempest; ed. by Rolfe.

Series. Usually omit. If necessary to distinguish between different copies give in curves after title, in abbreviation.

Two titles in one book. Give both, connecting by the & sign.

Dates of proceedings. Give after title, e. g. 1900-01.

Publisher

Give surname of first publisher named.

Give all surnames in firm if necessary to distinguish between similar firm names.

Year of publication

Use title page date if given, otherwise last copyright date, or preface date. Do not use brackets if date is supplied from some source other than title page. If no date is found use abbreviation n. d. (no date).

Volume

Enter number of volume if more than one in the volume column. Enter the number of parts if in parts, e. g. pt. 1² Indicate series numbers when more than one as in the case of some periodicals, e. g. o. s. 26 n. s. 13 (old series 26, new series 13). If two volumes are bound in one they may be indicated in this way, 2 in 1. Do not use an abbreviation, v. or vol. in the volume column. Simply the number itself is sufficient.

Source

Surname of dealer, if a purchase; of binder, if added by binding.
Name of donor, if a gift.

Cost

Actual amount paid by library. Do not divide the cost of a set, but give total opposite first volume entered.

Added by

By checking on the line of the book, in the columns headed, Gift, Binding, it is possible to keep count of these different sources and the number of volumes added from them to the library in a given period. It is important to keep these records separate in order to save time when the annual report is made up.

Rebinding

The cost and number of books rebound may be kept in this column and the same figured up at the end of the year with very little added effort.

Withdrawn

When a book is withdrawn, enter **date** and cause in the withdrawn column, to show the final disposition of **the volume**. A separate record kept in the Withdrawal Book shows the total **number** of books withdrawn from the library. The actual number of volumes **in the library** may be ascertained by subtracting the number of withdrawals **from the total accession number**.

Remarks

In the remarks column may be written **any** information desired not already provided for in the other columns.

Ditto

The ditto mark is a great time saver **in accessioning** long sets and may be used to advantage wherever possible. One ditto mark is sufficient in a column and the rows should be evenly kept.

Withdrawn

When a book is withdrawn, enter date and cause in the withdrawn column, to show the final disposition of the volume. A separate record kept in the Withdrawal Book shows the total number of books withdrawn from the library. The actual number of volumes in the library may be ascertained by subtracting the number of withdrawals from the total accession number.

Remarks

In the remarks column may be written any information desired not already provided for in the other columns.

Ditto

The ditto mark is a great time saver in accessioning long sets and may be used to advantage wherever possible. One ditto mark is sufficient in a column and the rows should be evenly kept.
